



Miroslava Jašović-Gašić

Professor, MD, PhD

She is neuropsychiatrist, forensic psychiatrist, retired full Professor of Psychiatry at the School of Medicine, University of Belgrade, member of the Academy of Medical Sciences, Serbian Medical Society.

She graduated as one of best generation students at the School of Medicine, University of Belgrade and was awarded with Medical Student Award (1970). She completed specialization in Neuropsychiatry (1974-1977) with excellent marks and during the specialization attended on and completed postgraduate course in psychotherapy at the School of Medicine, University of Belgrade (1974-1976, BS). She obtained PhD on 1980 with doctoral thesis from the field of Psychiatry (Psychosomatics and Psycho-Dermatology). Her academic career started on Department for Psychiatry at the School of Medicine, University of Belgrade as Assistant Doctor, than Assistant Professor (1988), Associate Professor (1993), and full Professor of Psychiatry (1994-2011).

She was Head of Department for Psychotic Disorders at the Institute for Psychiatry, Clinical Centre of Serbia (CCS) in Belgrade (1993-2011), Director of the Institute (today Clinic) for Psychiatry, UCS Belgrade (2005-2011), Head of the Department for Psychiatry at the School of Medicine, University of Belgrade (2005-2011), Editor in Chief of the national psychiatric journal "Engrami" (2008-2014), President of the Serbian Psychiatric Association (2007-2010), President of the Central-European Neuropsychopharmacology Association (2010) and member of the Ethical Committee of the CCS (until 2011).

She is member of the Academy of Medical Science, Serbian Medical Society (since 2016), Vice-President of the Court of Honour, Medical Chamber of Belgrade (since 2009, in two terms), member of Editorial Board of the international journal *Psychiatria Danubina* where was Guest Editor in Chief in 2009 (Vol. 21).

She is member of the European Psychiatric Association, the American Psychiatric Association and Board member of the Central-European Neuropsychopharmacology Association.

She was active participant and principal investigator of numerous projects and clinical trials. She has been included in followed projects: Guy's Hospital, London and Institute for Psychiatry, School of Medicine, University Clinical Centre Belgrade - Collaborative Joint Project: *Psychosocial adjustment to breast cancer and its treatment*; Yugoslav Ministry of Health & British Council; Yugoslav Ministry of Health and Science Study: *Depressive Syndrome in Schizophrenia: etiological and pharmacological possibilities*; Yugoslav Ministry of Health and Science Study: *Pathogenetic Processes in Schizophrenia: Oxidative Stress, Cognition and Pharmacological Modifications* (from 2001); *New molecules in controlling secretion of the GH and energetic homeostasis in humans* (from 2006). She was included in numerous studies and clinical trials (mostly as a Principal investigator) in her rich academic, scientific and professional career.

She published 452 papers, among them 62 are publication are CC or SCI indexed (ISI-Web of Science) with total score of scientific competence of 736,3 and citete index of 243 (University Library "Svetozar Marković").

She is Laureate of Life Achievements Award, awarded by the Serbian Medical Society in 2014.
