Professor, MD, PhD

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Born on 1957 in Teslić (Bosnia and Herzegovina). He has been graduated at the Faculty of Medicine, University of Tuzla, in 1982. Following, he was obtained a diploma in Neuropsychiatry as a medical specialty in 1991, in the Military Medical Hospital Belgrade (Serbia).

He has completed postgraduate studies in the field of Biomedicine at the Faculty of Medicine in Rijeka (Croatia), mentored by Professor Tanja Frančišković and has completed master studies on a topic “Psychological consequences of women exposed to chronic war stress”. In 2008 he got a PhD degree working with the same mentor on a topic “Secondary traumatization of wives of war veterans with posttraumatic stress disorder”.

He has been working at the Psychiatric Clinic in Mostar since 1994 and currently holds the position of Chief Psychiatrist at the Clinic. He has held the position of University Clinical Hospital Mostar Director Assistant since 2011. In 2013 became Dean of Department for Psychiatry Desk, Faculty of Medicine (University of Mostar) and became Associate Professor in the following year.

So far, he has published over 50 professional and scientific papers in international and national journals and participated in dozens of domestic and international scientific conferences. Also, he is the author of one of the official students’ books and seven chapters in various professional books.
