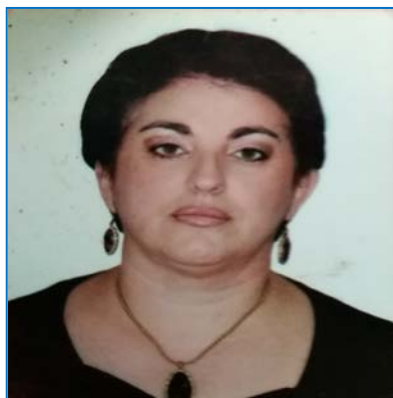




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She has graduated at the School of Medicine, University of Banja Luka (Bosnia and Herzegovina) on 1993, completed Psychiatry training on 2000 (University of Novi Sad, Serbia), Master Degree (MSc) at the University of Banja Luka (2008) and Doctoral thesis (PhD) on 2014 (University of Banja Luka). She completed two-years subspecialisation on Forensic Psychiatry on 2010 (University of Kragujevac, Serbia). As a GP she worked in primary health care in Čelinac and Banja Luka (1994 – 1995), and since 1995 she is at the Clinic for Psychiatry (University Clinical Centre of the Republic of Srpska, Banja Luka). She is Director of the Clinic for Psychiatry Banja Luka since 2010. Since 2003 she is forensic expert for the court (appointed by the Ministry of Justice of Republic of Srpska). She is Associate Professor and lecturer at the PanEuropean University „Aperion“ Banja Luka: Colledge of the Health Sciences (Health Psychology, since 2017) and Faculty of Law (Forensic Psychiatry, since 2014 and Forensic Psychology and Psychopathology, since 2017). She is lecturer and Professor at the Colledge for Health Science Prijedor since 2004. She was Assistant at the Department of Psychiatry (School of Medicine, University of Banja Luka). She is a member of Medical Chamber of the Republic of Srpska, as well as several national associations (Member of the Court of Honor in the Psychiatric Association of Bosnia-Herzegovina, Psychiatric Association of the Republic of Srpska, President of the Association of Experts for Alcoholism and Other Addictions of Bosnia and Herzegovina). She is founder and President of the Board of the Club of the Treated Alcoholics of the City of the Banja Luka. She has been published two books (forensic psychiatry), two books chapters (addictions and dermatology), 50 professional and 10 scientific papers (mostly from addictions).
